The Nuki Smart Lock 2.0 includes Bluetooth 5 for improved range, enhanced internal processing power for speed of use, a door sensor for at-a-glance status updates on your home door, plus full Apple HomeKit compatibility. It has been specifically created to cater for the common UK oval-cylinder lock, whilst retaining Nuki's easily-installed retrofitting and integrates with existing Smart Home solutions.
