



## Nuki is now climate neutral

Sustainability has been one of Nuki's declared guiding principles right from the start. Together with ClimatePartner, Nuki supports a climate protection project in Nanyang Danjiang, China.

Graz, May 12th, 2020 - Graz-based smart home pioneer Nuki is now working climate-neutral. This was achieved on the one hand through a number of measures set within the company and on the other hand through the compensation of unavoidable emissions.

"Sustainability has always been important to us," explains Martin Pansy, CEO of Nuki Home Solutions. "Our Nuki Smart Lock is manufactured in Europe, all of our company vehicles run on electricity, and through our Green Mobility project, we encourage our employees to get to work in a climate-friendly manner by bike or public transport." Despite small and large efforts, there will always be unavoidable emissions. Nuki Home Solutions compensates for this together with ClimatePartner.

### Sun instead of coal

Far from the booming metropolises in eastern China, life is simple and basic. In rural Xichuan in Henan province, more than three-quarters of the population live in simple huts. Cooking is done on small coal ovens, which produce an immense amount of CO<sub>2</sub>. ClimatePartner's climate protection project equips families with simple but highly efficient solar cookers. These parabolic mirrors concentrate the sunlight and concentrate it directly on the cooking vessel. 100,000 stoves have already been distributed, and around 350,000 people benefit directly from this support.

### Sustainable help

The use of solar cookers not only reduces emissions. Several secondary effects ensure a sustainable improvement in life. People save money on coal, thus protecting forests and ecosystems and avoiding the harmful smoke from their previous coal stoves. In addition, jobs are created locally by the production of the stoves.

### Saved almost 250,000 kg of CO<sub>2</sub>

"Climate protection and the economy must not be mutually exclusive," explains Martin Pansy. "I am very happy that we have found a reliable partner in ClimatePartner and were able to achieve this goal, which is so important to me personally, so early in our company's history - our company is carbon neutral."
