The high-capacity power pack can be fully charged in about 10 hours using a regular mains adapter. However, the USB-C charging port on the base of the Power Pack can also be used during operation. For example, the Power Pack can be charged with a conventional power bank during use or even permanently supplied with power. This is a great advantage especially in case of longer absences - for example when renting out short rental apartments.
