



Smart door opener: Nuki Box makes the intercom smarter than ever before

The Nuki Box opens main entrance doors in apartment buildings and is installed directly behind the intercom panel. Due to its GSM module the Nuki Box operates without WiFi connection and is now also available for consumers.

Graz (Austria) – 02/03/2021. Following the continued success of the Nuki Box within the B2B market, from today onwards the technology will also be available for consumers. The Nuki Box turns the intercom system at the main entrance of an apartment complex into a smart gateway, allowing all residents to enjoy the benefits of a smart main entrance door.

A keyless life

Since 2016, the Nuki Smart Lock has allowed you to open the front door of your house or apartment via your smartphone. A bit later, the Nuki Opener came onto the market and made it possible for users to 'smarten up' the main entrance door of apartment buildings via the personal intercom of their own apartment. With the Nuki Box, Nuki goes one step further. The Nuki Box is installed directly behind the intercom panel at the main entrance door instead of taking the "detour" via the personal intercom, allowing all residents to control the main entrance via the Nuki app.

"It is our mission at Nuki to provide smart access solutions that enable a keyless life. With the Nuki Box, we want to ensure that all residents of an apartment complex can enjoy the benefits of a Smart Lock. Until now the Nuki Box was only sold to the business customer segment. Numerous customer inquiries have encouraged us to further develop the Nuki Box and make it available to end customers. With this product we create an additional possibility to manage the main entrance doors with the proven solution from Nuki," says Martin Pansy, CEO of Nuki.

Box or Opener?

The Nuki Box closes a small gap in the product portfolio - even compared to the Nuki Opener. Both products can turn the main entrance door in apartment buildings into a smart door, but in different ways. The Opener **takes the "detour" via the personal intercom phone**, so the function can only be used by the resident of this one apartment. The Nuki Box, on the other hand, is installed invisibly behind the intercom panel at the front door, making the door smart for all residents.

Compatible with every intercom

The Nuki Box was developed with universal compatibility in mind. Therefore, it works for any intercom system with an electronic door opener. In addition, the Nuki Box does not require a WiFi connection to work. The Box has a Bluetooth connection like the Nuki Smart Lock and also includes an integrated eSIM, with a five-year flat rate, that provides network connectivity.

Individuals who do not own a smartphone can also enjoy the benefits of the Nuki Box. The Box is compatible with the Nuki Fob, a small remote control that allows you to open the door with a single touch.

A convenient and secure solution

Each Nuki Box has an administrator who sets up individual accounts for residents in the building complex. Residents who have been granted access rights can control the Nuki Box via the Nuki app. Users' data is protected at all times. For example, only authorized persons can check the activity log of their particular account. This is also not visible to the administrator.
