Automatic door opening is even better

Automatic door opening, or Auto Unlock, is by far the most popular feature of all Nuki Smart Locks. To make the feature even more accessible, it has been given its own menu item in the settings. Alongside the various options, you will find a clearly illustrated explanation of how Auto Unlock works. If a lock in a home is opened via Auto Unlock, the new option "Consider nearby devices" deactivates automatic door opening on other Smart Locks in the same home. This means that users can also use Auto Unlock on two or more doors in the same home.

MQTT integrates Nuki into local smart home installations
